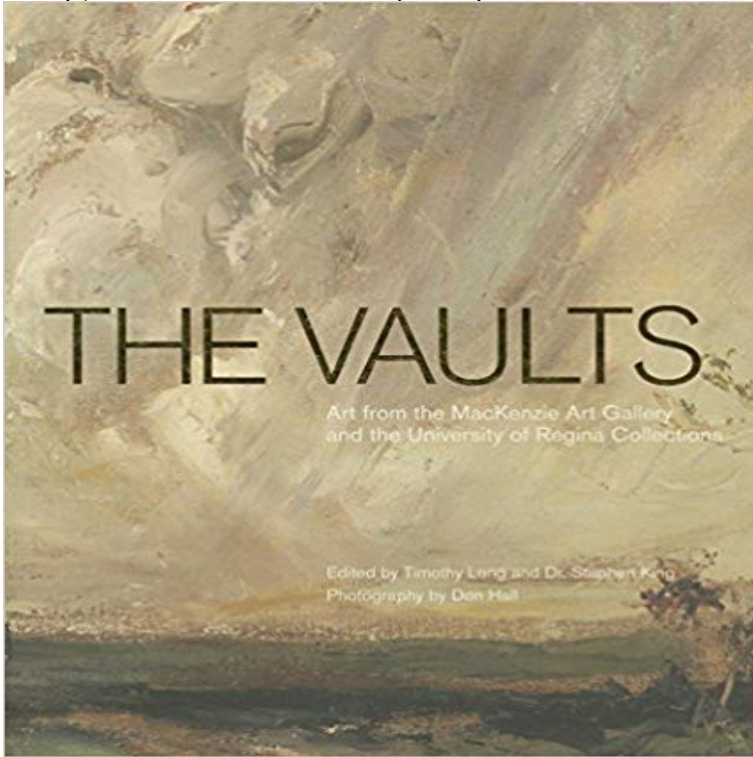


The Vaults: Art from the MacKenzie Art Gallery and the University of Regina Collections (UR)
