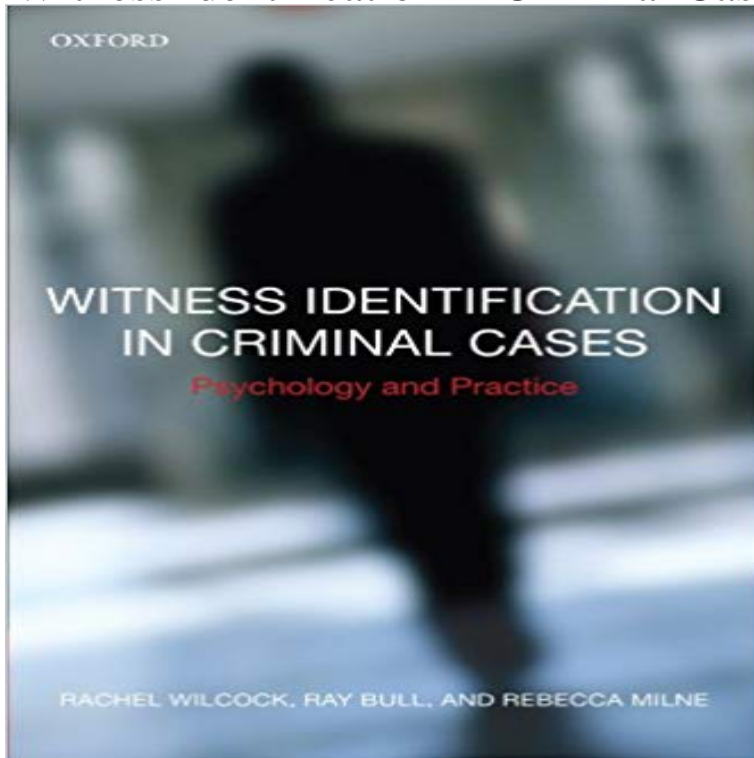


Witness Identification in Criminal Cases: Psychology and Practice
