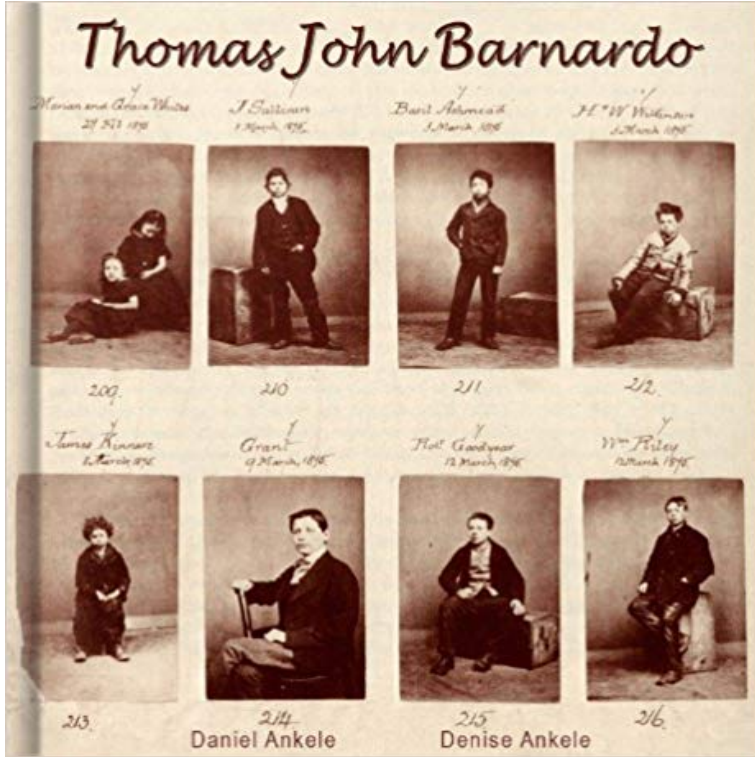


Thomas John Barnardo: British Portrait Reproductions

BORN: July 4, 1845 in Dublin, Ireland. DIED: September 19, 1905 in London, England. MEDIUM: Photography INTERESTING FACTS: Barnardo converted to Christianity in 1862. He studied medicine with the plan of becoming a medical missionary to the China Inland Mission. Barnardo discovered the plight of orphans in London while a student. After the Missionary Conference in 1867, he received aid from Lord Shaftesbury and Robert Barclay to build his first home for destitute children. In 1874, Barnardo opened a photographic department at the Stepney Boys Home. It was from then on that he photographed every child that entered one of his homes. By 1878, Barnardo had established fifty orphanages in London. NOTABLE WORKS: Annie Evans, Girls Village Home in England, Thomas Marme and The First Group of Boys who Emigrated to Canada.
