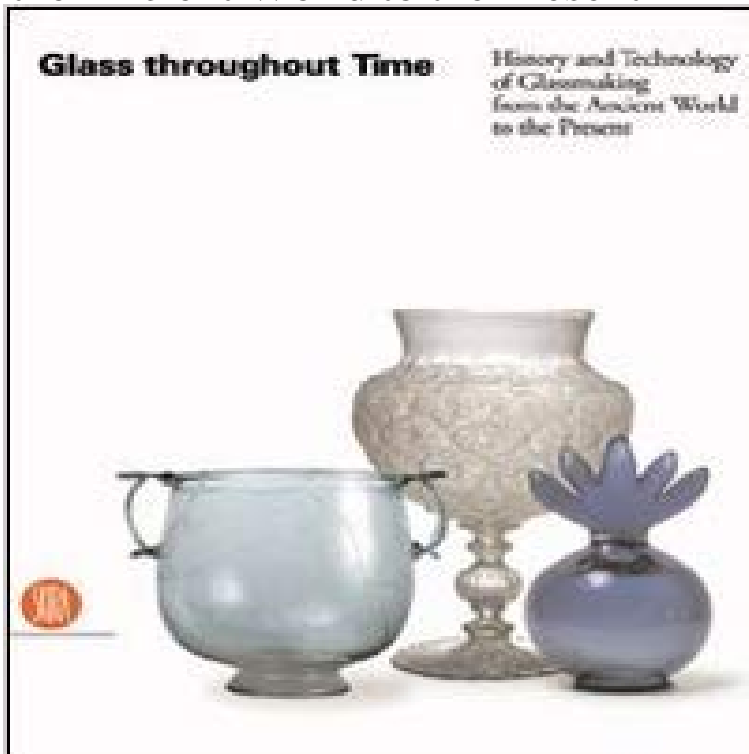


Glass Throughout Time: History and Technology of Glassmaking from the Ancient World to the Present
