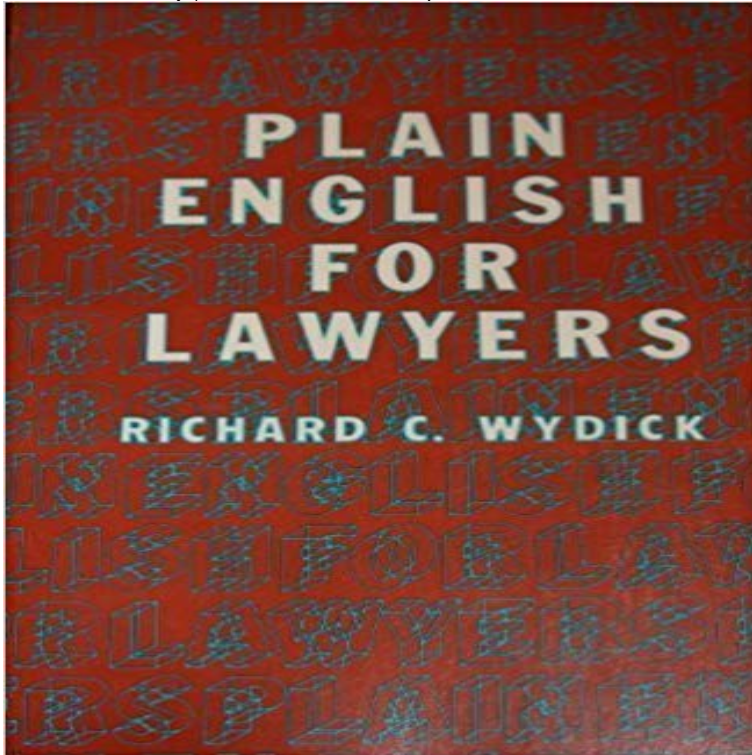


Plain English for lawyers
