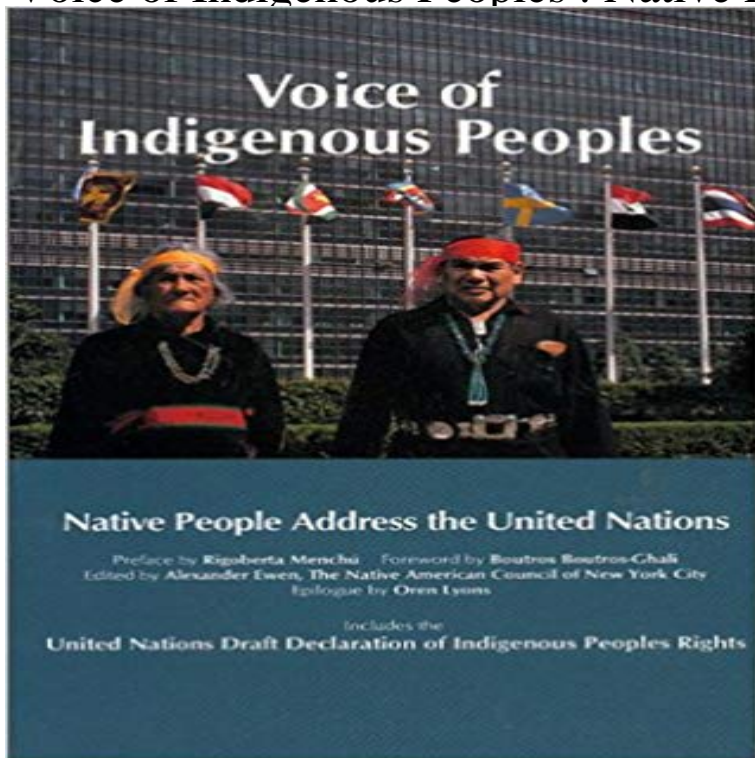


Voice of Indigenous Peoples : Native People Address the United Nations
